



Guests arriving from abroad

When you arrive from outside Germany, a distinction must be made between non-risk areas, risk areas, high incidence areas and virus variant areas.

Check this [up-to-date list of countries](#) on the RKI website to see which area currently belongs to which risk group. The document also gives an overview of recent changes.

Entry from a non-risk area: unrestricted entry with a certificate not older than 48 hours of a negative rapid test from a test center.

Entry from a risk area: 10 days quarantine, except immunized and tested persons. A negative rapid test not older than 48 hours or a PCR test not older than 72 hours is required.

Entry from a high incidence area: 10 days quarantine, except immunized persons. On entry, non-immunized persons require a rapid test not older than 48 hours or a PCR test not older than 72 hours. Quarantine shortening no earlier than day 5 with a negative rapid test or a PCR.

Entry from a virus variant area (“area of variant of concern”): On entry, a negative rapid test not older than 24 hours is required or a PCR test not older than 72 hours. 14 days quarantine for everyone, including for immunized persons!
